T'Puram school adjudged top govt school in India

Nine other schools in the state have also found a place in the top 10 rankings under various categories

KENDRIYA Vidyalaya, Pattom here, has been adjudged the best government school in the country in the 'Education World India School Rankings 2017'. Nine other schools in the state have also found a place in the top 10 rankings under various categories.

There are four other entrants from Kerala in the country's Top Government Day Schools' category. They are GVHSS for Girls, Kozhikode (No 3); Kendriya Vidyalaya, West Palakkad (No 7); Kendriya Vidyalaya, Purantattukara, Thrissur (No 8); and Kendriya Vidyalaya, Keitron Nagar, Kannur (No 9).

In the 'Top 10 Government Boarding Schools' category, Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalaya in Chendayad (Kannur), Chennithala (Alappuzha) and Neri-amangalam (Ernakulam) have been ranked third, fourth and seventh places respectively.

While Pallikoodam School, Kottayam, clinched the all-India ninth spot in the 'Day-cum-Boarding Schools' category, Sad-

hbavana World School, Kozhikode landed in the eighth spot in the nationwide 'International Day Schools' category.

Elaborate survey

The survey was commissioned by the country's leading education news magazine Education World. A total of 12,367 parents, teachers, principals, educationists and senior students in 27 cities were interviewed over a period of four months by the market research

company Care to rate and rank 1,000 of the country's most well-known schools against 14 parameters of education excellence.

The parameters were academic reputation, community service, competence of faculty, individual attention to students, leadership and management, quality life skills education and conflict management, co-curricular education, internationalism, parental involvement, teacher welfare and development, value for money sports education, safety and hygiene and infrastructure provision.

Kerala rankings

St Thomas School here was adjudged No 1 in the 'Co-ed Boarding Schools' category. Poojara Public School, Manjeri, and the Thomas Resurrection School, Thiruvalla, bagged second and third spots respectively, in the 'Co-ed Day Schools' category. Resurrection Public School, Kalamassery, emerged on top, Chuvanna Varada, Vaduthala, and Rajagal Christa Jayanthi Public School, Kozhikode, bagged second and third spots. Two schools from Thiruvananthapuram were the winners in the 'Top Day Schools' category. While Loyola School emerged on top, St Joseph's Secondary School clinched the second spot. In the 'Co-ed Boarding Schools' category, Pallikoodam School, Kottayam is the top six. The Choice School, Kochi, and St Peter's Senior Secondary School, Kochi, took second and third spots.

KV Pattom retains top spot in school ranking survey

Thiruvananthapuram: Several schools in the state have featured in the top 10 list released by Delhi-based news magazine Education World. The list was released as part of its 11th annual school rankings survey 2017 conducted in association with Centre for Forecasting and Research (C fore), Kendriya Vidyalaya, Pattom, Thiruvananthapuram retained its top spot in the government day school category while Pallikoodam School, Kottayam was ranked ninth in the day-cum-boarding school category.

The survey with a sample respondents' database of 12,367 educationists, principals, teachers, parents and students in 27 cities, education hubs across the country, which was released in Bengaluru on Friday, rated and ranked country's top 1,000 schools in 14 categories including day boys, girls, co-ed, day-cum-boarding, legacy boarding and international schools. The top-ranked schools will be felicitated in Gurugao on September 22-23.

As per the ratings, Step by Step, Noida (day co-ed), DPS, RK Puram, Delhi and Greenwood High, Bangalore (day-cum-boarding), The JB Petal High School for Girls, Mumbai (all girls) and Campion School, Fort, Mumbai (all-boys) were ranked India's most admired Day Schools. In the traditional/legacy boarding schools category, Rishi Valley School, Chittoor (co-ed), and The Doon School, Dehradun (all-boys) retained their top positions while Seindia Ramya Vidyalaya, Gwalior (all-girls) moved two positions up from last year to take the top spot this year.

Dhirubhai Ambani International, Mumbai (day), Indus International, Bangalore (day-cum-boarding) and Woodstock School, Massachusetts (wholly residential) were top-ranked in the international schools category.

In addition, India's top government day and residential schools, special needs and budget private schools were also rated and ranked. Oak Grove School, Massachusetts (Utta-rakshastri) is the number one government boarding school while Tacoma Autism Centre - School of Hope, Delhi retained its number one position among special needs schools and Muni International School, Delhi was top-ranked in the budget private school category.

"The rankings will help parents countrywide to choose the most suitable school for their children and school managements to compare themselves with other schools in their categories on a wide range of parameters," said Dilip Thakore, founder-editor of Education World.

Kendriya Vidyalaya, Pattom, has been adjudged the best government day school in the country in the 'Education World India School Rankings' for the third consecutive year.

Other schools in the State also figure in the top 42 rankings in various categories.

In the 'Government Day School' category, Government Vocational Higher Secondary School for Girls, Nadakkavu, Kozhikode, is ranked third.

Ranks seven to nine have gone to Kendriya Vidyalayas - KV West Palakkad, is seventh, KV Parangankkara, Thiruvananthapuram, is eighth, and KV, Kottayam Nagar, Kottayam, is in ninth position.

Three JVs in top 10

Three Jawahar Nandanam Vidyalayas (JNVs) have found a place in the top 10 'Government Boarding Schools' category. These include JNV, Chendrayad, Kottayam, ranked three; JNV, Chennithala, Alappuzha, ranked four; and JNV, Nerimangalam, Ernakulam, ranked seven.

In the best International Day School category, Southwestern World School, Kozhikode, clinched the

eighth position. St. Thomas Residential School, Thiruvananthapuram, is ranked 11th in the 'Best Co-

ed Boarding School' category. Pallikoodam School, Kottayam, has been placed ninth in the 'Best Co-ed Day-cum Boarding' category. The Choice School, Kochi, follows in 10th position.

Extensive survey

'Education World' has been publishing the India school rankings with C Fite, a Delhi-based market research and opinion polls agency, for many years.

As many as 12,367 parents, teachers, Principals, educationists, and senior students in 27 cities were interviewed over four months to rate 1,000 schools in 11 categories.

The parameters of assessment include academic reputation, faculty competence, leadership and management quality, sports education, teacher welfare and development, life skills education, conflict management, special needs education, co-curricular education, internationalism, conflict management, and so on.

The awards for the schools will be presented at the Education World India School Rankings Awards 2017 in New Delhi on September 22.
